The new version of SAVI is no different in this context and keeping with the modernisation of this software below you will find two tables with explanations

Table 1 – Old Terminology > New Terminology

Old Term	New Term
HMMA	CDT (<i>Crate Transfer Docket</i>)
Check In	Despatch
Check Out	Receipt
Transfer Out	Despatch
Transfer In	Receipt
In Transit	In Transit
ORD-12345-CML (<i>crate order #</i>)	ORD0000012

Table 2 – New Descriptions

Term	Meaning
CDT (<i>Crate Transfer Docket</i>)	A printed copy of any transaction of crates moved from one account to another account (<i>The docket # has a prefix of ABRA</i>)
Despatch	A transaction that de-hires crates from a supplier account to another account, this could be a Coles DC or another Supplier account
Receipt	A transaction that hires crates onto a supplier account from another account, this could be a RRU or another Supplier account

SAVI – Terminology



In Transit	A Despatch that is waiting for the receiving site to complete the transaction by performing a Receipt
ORD0000012	A system generated Order Number for every crate order placed in SAVI. All orders are collected from Logtek RRU's
Open	Refers to any crate orders in the system that have not been collected
Completed	All transactions in SAVI that have been completed
Cancelled	Any Crate Orders that have been cancelled by either the supplier or the administrator
Discrepant	When a Qty or crate types received is different from the Despatched Qty
